

We will be selecting a Class Representative to speak at each graduation ceremony. If you think you have what it takes to represent your class, this is your chance. We are looking for a motivated, well spoken, and out-going person to represent PA Cyber and your graduating class.

Rules and Guidelines

- Applicant must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA.
- Applicant must have met or be working towards meeting all PA Cyber graduation requirements.
- Applicant must participate in the graduation ceremony.
- Application and entry due Friday, March 22nd, 2024. (see dates below)
- No late entries will be accepted.
- The Class Representative Application must accompany your essay. Essays received without the application will not be accepted.
- Essays must be submitted from within the application itself.

Dates

- 1st Essay Due: Friday, March 22nd, 2024
- Top 6 Finalists for Each Site Notified: Friday, April 5th, 2024
- 2nd Essay Due: Friday, April 19th, 2024
- Class Representatives Notified: Friday, May 3rd, 2024
 - o Central/Eastern Graduation: Kutztown University on Wednesday, June 5th at 2:00 pm
 - $_{\odot}$ $\,$ Western Graduation: Robert Morris University on Friday, June 7th at 12:00 pm $\,$

Requirements

- Class Representative must be able to speak in front of a large audience.
- 1st Essay Topic: "Why I Should be the 2024 PA Cyber Class Representative."
- **2nd Essay Topic:** Applicant's choice (this will be the speech read by the Class Representative at graduation).
- Essay must be no more than 600 words.
 - > Persuasive, inspirational message.
 - Essay should have an introduction, body, and conclusion addressing past, present, and future.
 - Essay should use no more than three (3) quotes, each with credit given.

Plagiarism will not be tolerated. A plagiarized essay will be automatically disqualified.

Evaluation

- Based on the entries received, the Graduation Committee will identify 6 finalists for each graduation ceremony.
- Only the Top 6 Finalists for each site will compose a second essay.
- Final selection of the two Class Representatives will be recommended by the Graduation committee and approved by Senior Administration.
- All applicants will be evaluated on the following:
 - Clarity of message
 - o Grammar, syntax, and punctuation
 - High school and College courses and credits earned
 - o Attendance
